Attendance focus

As you will be aware we have been focussing on improving our school attendance over the last few months. We have continued to reward termly 100% attendance and also handed out several certificates for 100% attendance across the whole school year. As a school we have to meet a government target of 96% and an academy Trust target of 97%. Unfortunately last year's attendance at TPA did not meet these targets with us achieving a whole school figure of 94%. Schools are measured on how proactive they are at ensuring that children are in school, on time, everyday. Please help us to make sure that your child's attendance is the best it can be by avoiding booking holidays in term time and not booking medical appointments during the school day. For those children who have attendance below 96% we will send out letter communication to inform families of this during the autumn term. As part of this we may ask parents to attend a meeting to discuss your child's attendance.

UCI Cycling World Championships - Friday 27th September

You may have seen that on Friday 27th September there will be some disruption in the Tadcaster area with road closures for the UCI Cycling World Championship Events which are taking place between 21st and 29th September. On Friday 27th September, the race comes through Tadcaster via the A162/A659 (High Street)/Wighill Lane under a rolling road closure between 10:00am and 11:00am, but also between 3:15pm and 4:15pm. As the road will be closed, this will affect pedestrians as well as drivers and in order to avoid this disruption children can be picked up at 2.30pm from school. It will also allow those children who are interested in cycling to watch this historic event.
