#### Last week's attendance


Our school attendance target is 97%. Please see last week's

### Attendance at Tadcaster Primary Academy

Last half term we monitored the attendance of our pupils in preparation to share your child's attendance since September. In the next few weeks school will be contacting those parents who have children with attendance that currently stands below 90% which the government defines as Persistent Absentee level. These families will be contacted by school to discuss their child's attendance and in some cases to create an action plan to look at how school and families can work together to improve this figure. School's are legally obliged to keep record of attendance and to communicate with families where attendance is a concern. We also have to report attendance figures to our academy trust and the local authority. As always we ask that our families try to ensure children are in school, on time, every day. Thank you for your support with this.
