*As Government guidance states, your child's attendance is compulsory in school and unless they are unwell we ask that you ensure they are in school, on time, every day. Thank you.




Thank you Mrs Heptonstall!



Attendance focus at TPA

As you will be aware we have been focussing on improving our school attendance. As a school we have to meet a government target of 96% and an academy Trust target of 97%. Schools are measured on how proactive they are at ensuring their children are in school, on time, everyday. Please help us to make sure that your child's attendance is the best it can be by avoiding booking holidays in term time and not booking medical appointments during the school day. For those children who have attendance below 96% we have sent out letter communication this week to inform families. As part of this drive we may ask parents and carers to attend a meeting to discuss their
