A message from Miss Towler...

Dear Parents and Carers,

Over the last two weeks all of our year 1 children completed their Phonics screening assessments with Mr Ramzan and Mr Foster. The children were absolutely fantastic and really showed off all of their learning. We will inform parents and carers of the outcomes from the screener in their end of year reports.

All of our year 4 children have completed the standard multiplication test. The children had to answer 25 questions on multiplication calculations up to 12x12 – the difficulty being they only had 6 seconds to answer each question. The children were great and have worked very hard in their class team to improve their times tables knowledge. One of the benefits of having a Year 3 and 4 class is that the Year 3 children are regularly practising their multiplication facts and are coming on a treat! We were really proud of how hard they tried during these assessments.

By the time you receive this newsletter I will be with Team Kingswood having great fun on our residential adventure. I am sure the children will have an amazing time and I look forward to sharing more next week.

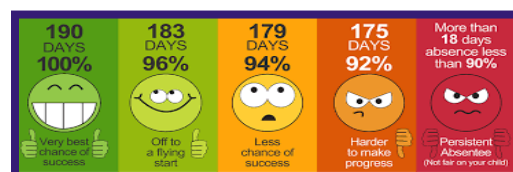
