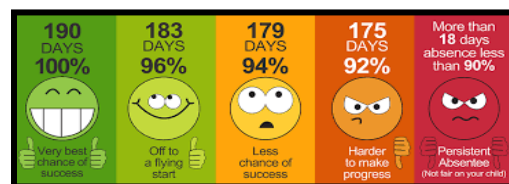
Our school R-Y6 attendance this week is: 97.08%
