SCIENCE:

In Science we are learning about Light - What is light? Light is a form of energy.

What is dark?

Dark is an absence of light. How do we see?

Light travels in straight lines. When light hits an object, it is reflected and enters our eyes. This is how we see the object.

How are shadows formed?

A shadow forms when an opaque, or non-transparent, object blocks light from passing through and reaching a surface on the other side.

In History we are learning about The Romans - When and where did the Romans settle in Yorkshire?

71AD to 410AD

What links does Tadcaster have to the Romans and York Minster?

The stone used for York Minster was magnesian limestone, a creamy-white colured rock that was quarried in Tadcaster.

The History Of Beer - Why did so many breweries get built in Tadcaster?

The quality of the water which is rich in lime sulphate.

GEOGRAPHY:

In Geography we are learning about Settlements – Why did people settle in Tadcaster?

Tadcaster had access to a bridging point, flat land for crops and water from the river.

Why do people live in Tadcaster today? Due to the facilities that are available including schools, shops, healthcare and transport links.

What types of farming do we have near us?

Diary, livestock and arable.

In PSHE we will be learning about

Living in the wider world What is a right? A choice to make your own opinion and entitlement to things such as education, religion and freedom of speech.

What is a responsibility?
A duty or something an individual should do such as following the law and rules.

What is a stereotype?
A fixed and oversimplified image of someone or a group of people based on a person's preconceived idea.

RE:

In RE we will learning about Religious Festivals - VVhy are festivals Important to the religions that celebrate them?

They help believers to remember important beliefs in their religion and bring faith communities together to celebrate their beliefs.

What do people do to celebrate different religious festivals?

People come together and partake in the eating of specially prepared food, decorate their homes and places of worship and give thanks.

ART:

In Art we will be learning about L5 Lowry - Who was L5 Lowry? Lowry was a painter who became

famous for his painting showing everyday scenes of working class life.

What techniques did LS Lowry use in his work?

Lowry painted in oils and only used the colours ochre, blue, black, white and red.
