Our school attendance target is 97%.

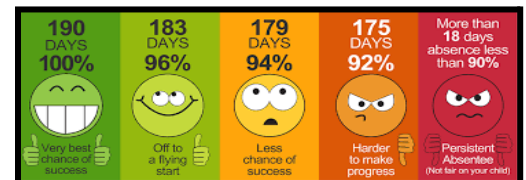

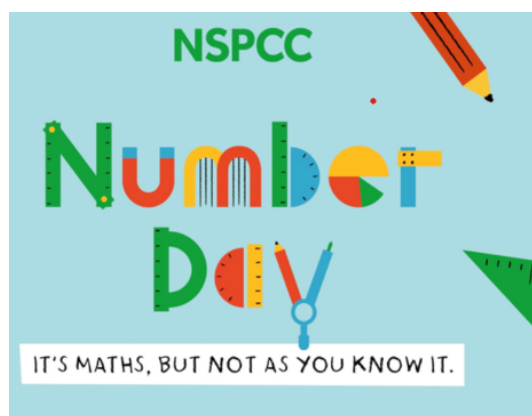
Parking arrangements

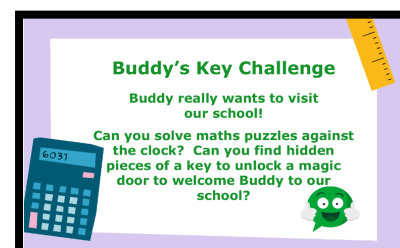


NSPCC Number Day - Friday 2nd February 9am - Parents & Carers Welcome

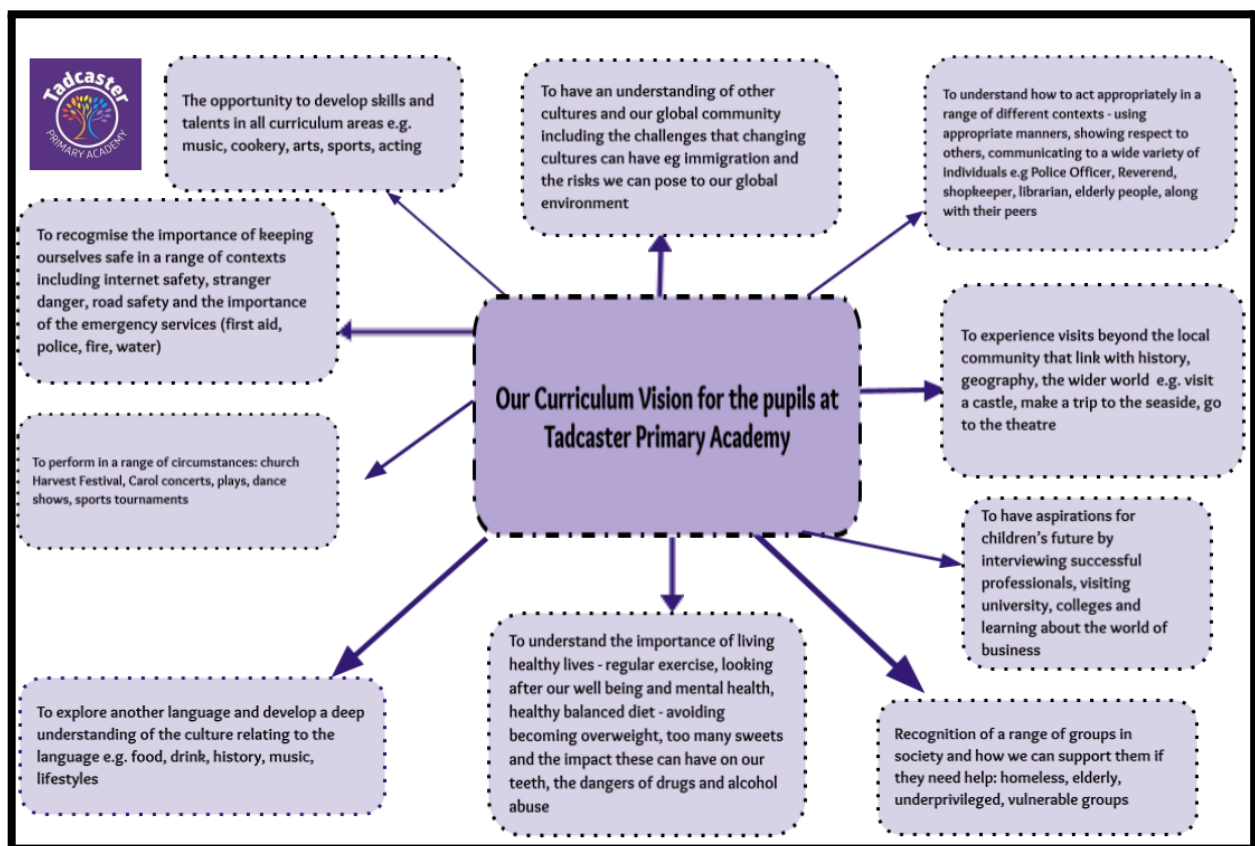

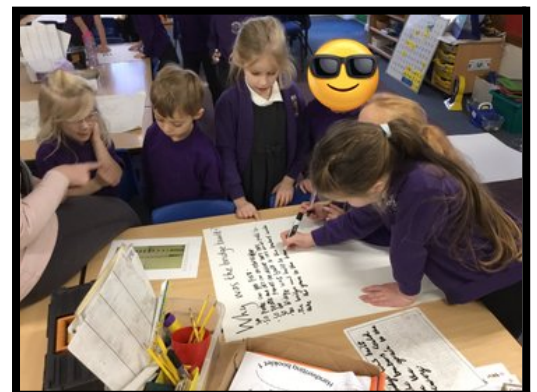
