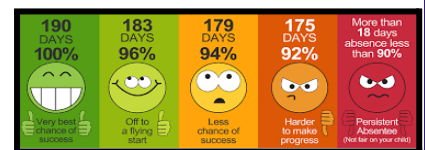
Our school R-Y6 attendance this week is: 98.11%

Jupiter: 97.41% Reception: 97.69% Neptune: 97.33%

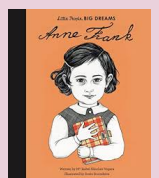
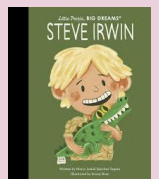
Nursery: 90.36%
