Transition arrangements

Next week the children will be moving into their new classes for September for our transition days. On Wednesday morning all children will be in their new classrooms with their new teaching teams. Year six will be taught by Mr Ramzan for the morning. The children will be dropped off in their normal classrooms and then will move into new classes after they have had registration. As we have swimming lessons for Years 5 and 6 on Wednesday afternoon the children will then spend the afternoon in their usual classes with their usual teaching team and then on Thursday will spend the full day in their new classes once again. Children will need to be dropped off and collected from their usual classrooms on Wednesday and Thursday.

Straight after school on Thursday, Parents and Carers are welcome to visit their child's new classrooms and speak with the teaching team.

From September the children will be taught in the following classrooms and with these class names:
