



\*As Government guidance states, your child's attendance is compulsory in school and unless they are unwell we ask that you ensure they are in school, on time, every day.


### New families come and see our school!

Well done to all these children and many many more who have been busy reading at home with their family members.







In school we regularly speak to our children about their safe adults. Safe adults are the people who they can turn to in times of worry, stress or crisis. Safe adults can include;




