### We perform throughout the year!

- ★ Autumn term: KS2 Harvest Festival at church. Christmas Extravaganza, 2 performances (one in church and one at school).
- ★ Spring Term: Young Voices concert.

#### **Playing instruments**

All of our KS2 children have the option to choose and learn to play an instrument with approved, specialist peripatetic teachers including strings, woodwind and piano/keyboard.



#### Music club

KS1 and 2 children have the opportunity to attend singing club every Tuesday after school throughout the year.

We work on a range of songs in readiness for any performance opportunities.

## **Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer**

Every child receives 1 hour of Music teaching a week in our school delivered by a Music specialist.

- EYFS pupils receive a music lesson based on traditional rhyme and song with lots of
  opportunities to explore instruments. We focus on pulse and link this to movement.
- KS1 pupils receive a 60 minute music lesson. This comprises of: A singing element
  which follows a kodaly style of learning using Voices Foundation and Jolly Music resources
  and incorporating lots of singing games. A listening element children explore music from
  different genres as set out in the Model Music curriculum. Children are also offered lots of
  opportunities to use instruments such as tuned and untuned percussion and
  Boomwhackers for playing and composing.
- **KS2 pupils** receive a 60 minute music lesson with a focus on developing singing, whole class teaching of recorders (Y3/4) and ukuleles (Y5/6). Pupils develop composition skills and explore musical dimensions through listening to many different genres of music.

Our provision includes: Sing Up! Young Voices Foundation, Jolly Music, Chrome music lab, tuned and untuned percussion, recorders and ukuleles.

All pupils attend a 20 minute whole school singing assembly every Tuesday delivered by a music specialist.

We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use the time to help our children prepare for our calendar of performances events. All of our events accessible for all children including those with SEND.
