Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a fabulous week in school and the children have certainly settled into their new class routines brilliantly. Wrap Around Care - Childcare Bookings for Schools

We have had a fantastic first week after launching our Wrap Around Care offer. Along with our breakfast club, which has been running since the summer term, we launched our after school club on Monday. Thank you to all our families who have booked their children places in our Wrap Around Care provision.

If you would like your child to access our after school club you can book a place using Child Care Bookings. The after school club offers both the Hub Club session with Miss Bell and Miss Wu from 3.30-5.30 and also a range of clubs (dodgeball, music, multiskills and dance) run by Danny, Drew and Mrs Oldfield from 3.30pm-4.30pm (just book session one on Childcare Bookings for Schools).

All clubs can be booked as part of the after school club offer and will be charged at the rate of £4.50 for the first hour or £9.00 for two hours.



Learning with Parents - Our School Digital Reading Log




