Our school attendance target is 97%.



Your Weekly Attendance Update

At this stage in the term we would expect that the majority of our children would have attendance of 100% as it is unusual for pupils to have time off after 25 days of school. If your child has had one day of absence then they will already have attendance which is below the government required figure of 96% or our Academy Trust target of 97%.
