Our school attendance target is 97%.

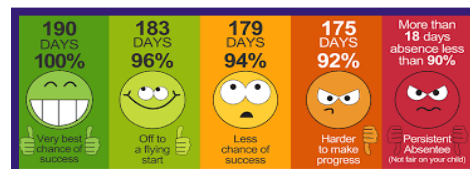
Team Neptune: 95.7% Top Team Attendance! 🙌

Curriculum Update - Please take a look at the curriculum updates from your child's class teacher below to find out what your child will be learning this term:



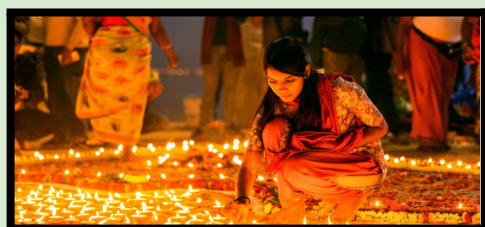
Team Venus (Nursery, Reception and Year One)

This term we are learning about 'The Polar Regions', we will be looking at animals that live in the polar regions and learn facts about these animals and what the climate is like and how the animals have adapted to live in this climate. We will continue Drawing Club and the children are very aware of what we do and draw on each day. So far we have adventured into the story 'The three little pigs' and looked at an episode from the past of 'Willo the Wisp'. Team Venus Year 1 will be learning about 'Transport' in History and how transportation in the past compares to transport today. In Religious Education we are looking at 'How and why we celebrate special times' within religious and non-religious

communities. In Science this term we are learning about 'Animals including Humans' - 'All about me'. We will be conducting experiments with the focus on our five senses. In PE we are focusing on gymnastics which includes jumping, balancing and mirroring. Mrs Oldfield and Miss Ambler will be teaching more new techniques in music and art. In Art the children will be making 3D sculptures. In Music Year 1 will be learning lots of new songs and using instruments to create musical conversations, Reception and Nursery will play singing games based on the theme of 'Bird Song' and learn to show the beat of music through movement.

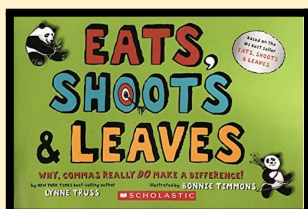
Team Saturn (Years Two, Three and Four)

Team Saturn has lots of interesting things to do and learn this term. In History we will be learning about local historical events, buildings, industry, maps and place names. In Geography we will look at settlements including different types, megacities and how we can save settlements from being destroyed. In RE we will look at festivals. This will include looking at what the festival is, when and how it is celebrated. In Science we will be looking at Light. We will learn about what light and dark is, how the eye detects light, shadows and reflection. In PE it is our turn to go swimming and will be taking part in the Dance Festival. Mrs Oldfield and Miss Ambler will be teaching more new techniques in music and art respectively. We will continue to develop our French conversational skills covering the topics of colour, parts of the body, family, food and drink.



Team Neptune (Years Four, Five and Six)

In English we are writing DIY Colour Poems & doing biography writing on the theme of "My Hero". This could be a family member or ancestor who the children will enjoy collecting some information about at home to write up in class. In story writing we will be using a short film "The Lighthouse" practising writing dialogue to show character & setting descriptions. We will use the picture book "Eats, Shoots and Leaves" to explore how important a comma can be in affecting meaning. In Geography our topic is Where does our energy come from? We will learn about carbon emissions and global warming and the change towards generating electricity using renewable forms of energy including Drax now a major biomass power station. In RE, we will focus on Christianity and Islam exploring the question Is it better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity? First Miss Bell is teaching PSHE & in the second half term Miss Ambler is teaching Art. Mrs Oldfield is teaching music which will include 'Building a Groove' and 'Epoca' learning about Beat, rhythm, bass lines, riffs, articulation and tango. In PE we are exploring symmetry and asymmetry in gymnastics and practising striking and fielding games including tri golf and rounders. In Science we are learning about Forces. In DT we will be making cam mechanisms.
