Our school attendance this week for Y1-Y6 is: **96.71%**


Our school attendance target is **97%**.

How can I keep my child safe online? An update from our Computing Lead Mr Foster.



Following on from last week's updates, please find the next installment of strategies you can use to support with online safety.



Finding the right questions to ask

As part of conversations with your child about online content, you can explore the internet together and talk about what you find. There are no wrong questions, but the following questions could be helpful.

Ask open questions such as:

- how does this post make you feel?
- who shared this content?
- why do you think they posted it?

Explain that not everything online is true and make it a habit to question online content together.



Did you know?

Recent Ofcom research shows that 58% of children aged 8 and older are not allowed phones in their bedroom at night.



Did you know?

You might not think your child has seen any worrying online content, but remember, you won't know until you ask.
