Our school attendance this week for Y1-Y6 is: **94.11%**

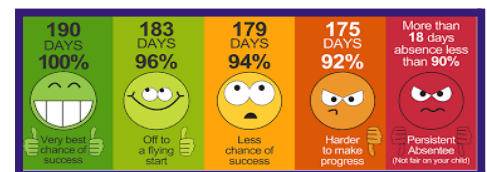
Our school attendance target is **97%**.
