Our school attendance this week for Y1-Y6 is: 94.61%

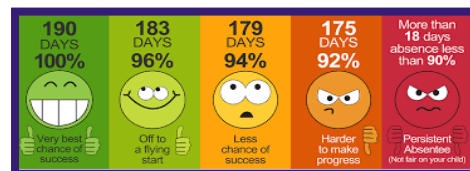
Our school attendance target is 97%.
