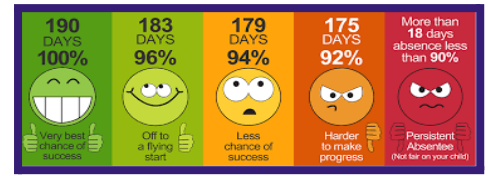
Our school attendance target is 97%.
